

Into My Arms COUNSELING SERIES

A nine-part series with accompanying curriculum for those who have suffered the pain of abortion.



I hope all is going well. I wanted to give you a quick update on the "In the Wildflowers" project. We are in full gear. We've got the fulfillment machine in motion and we are cranking out product. We have the marketing efforts underway, and we have signed 3 non-exclusive agreements with 3 different distributors so far, (Vision Video, The American Assosiation of Christian Counselors and the TPM group) and We are working on a number of others. We are also working on a deal with the Meier Clinics (a Christian-based Counseling organization that has 114 therapists in 10 states) to set up their counselors as the first batch of "go to" counselors for the end users to contact about going through the series. The ministries founder, Julie Woodley, has been on Moody radio, and the 700 club has agreed to film and air a reenactment of her life and help to promote the series. We are also working with EWTN, Relevant Radio, Joyce Meyer and Paula White to set up times where Julie can appear on their program and promote "In The Wildflowers".

Most importantly, we are getting tons of anecdotal evidence that this thing is becoming more than we ever dreamed of. It is an absolute homerun. We have had three, 3-day weekend retreats using the series and the results have been amazing. We have women who were broken and seemingly hopeless, who are now vibrant and on fire for Christ. They have been set free by coming to understand who their heavenly Father is, and how His love for them is unconditional. They want to dedicate their lives to helping others who were like them. It's pretty cool to see the hand of God upon all of this.

We will continue to work to set up more marketing agreements so we can get this resource out to has many people as we can. With that said, we are going to re-focus some of our energy again on raising the money to finish the editing of the second series that deals with the trauma associated with abortion. In the aftermath of the elections, there has never been a more critical time to get the second series, "Into My Arms" into the public square. In January, Congress is going to try and pass legislation that will grant abortion as an entitlement as opposed to a right. They, with the help of President Obama, are going to change the landscape of abortion for many years to come. They are going to try and reverse all of the efforts that pro-life has made, and they are going to take away any power from the states and the local authorities, to regulate. The right to life issue, will no longer have a chance to have a political solution.

This relationship is one that is about love and nurture, and it is etched upon their hearts by God. Their betrayal of this relationship is what is tormenting their spirits and has thrown them into the darkness.

"Into My Arms" is geared toward the post-abortive woman and those that wish to help them. We know that we will see the same type of results that we are seeing with "In the Wildflowers". We rejoice in the knowledge that there can be a new beginning for these women who believe they have committed an unforgivable sin, that not only can they be forgiven, but that they can experience the love of God. With that said, there is a secondary and extremely important role that the series can play. It can bring the story of the post-abortive woman into the light. By using the same paths of marketing and distribution that we are establishing for "Into The Wildflowers", we can bring the story of the post-abortive woman to the world. We can use radio, TV, internet, print and word of mouth to get the story out on a large scale. We can get it into the churches, the prisons, the seminaries, the armed forces, the ministries, the families and to the world at large. We can create a wave of awareness that if God is willing, could begin a new social movement to reaffirm the great gift of life that God has given us, and to create enough pressure to end the evil of abortion in this country.

We are two thirds of the way done with "Into My Arms". We need to find \$65,000 to complete the editing. Please pass this along to anyone who you think would like join our efforts.
